### Approval of Minutes

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## Old Business

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## New Business

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**Trailer Driver Reimbursement:** There was a discussion to reimburse the drivers who use their personal vehicle to transport the third trailer. Tammy Miller said she would double check the correct amount per mile with Mr. Nelson. A motion was made to reimburse the people who transport the third trailer with their personal vehicle with the amount designated after investigation by Sarah Ward, seconded by Andrea Haney. It was approved by those present.

After a short discussion, a motion was made to allocate \$2000 from the Booster funds to bolster the budget for the marching staff by Cami Avis, seconded by Saundi Pugh. It was approved by those present.
