In Attendance

There were 19 Booster members present plus Mrs. Parrott and Mr. Tallman.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the August meeting were read by the members. Scott Haney made a motion to accept the minutes as written, Andrea Haney seconded, and the minutes were approved by the members present.

Treasurer's Report

Committees

Uniforms: The Uniform Committee met at the end of last month. Design drawing have been sent to Mrs. Parrott; a virtual meeting will be set to discuss the designs.

Pit: Parents are still needed to help with competitions and football games.

Fundraising

SaveAround: The SaveAround fundraiser raised \$3,987.00 total with \$2,395 going to student accounts and \$1,592 going to the Band Booster account.

Polos: Cami Avis stated that she has a couple of items left over if anyone was interested in purchasing them. Next year the polo will be a different shirt style, but with the same design as before.

Buffalo Wild Wings: The BWW fundraiser raised \$460.19.

Old Business

Trailer: Tammy Miller showed the member present the design ideas for the trailers. She said that she was still waiting for some partial wrap designs. Some discussion was had about the designs. It was noted that carpet needs to be laid as soon as possible – Tammy said she would call a couple of places to get prices and timelines. The two new trailers will be used for transporting to the Pontiac Invitational.

New Business

Gift Card for Litten Family: Discussion was had about giving a donation to the Litten family; Wes was a member of the band and graduated last year. A motion was made to purchase a \$250 VISA gift card for the Litten Family by Cami Avis. Laura Allaman seconded the motion and it was approved by all members present.
